#### **ISSUE**

The HPRA is issuing this Safety Notice to raise awareness of an important update to the package insert for MiniMed Mio™ Advance Infusion Sets.

The user guide currently recommends filling 6mm and 9mm soft cannulas with 0.9U (0.009 ml) of insulin after inserting a new set. Unomedical a/s has determined that the correct fill cannula volume is 0.6U for both 6mm and 9mm soft cannulas.

The MiniMed<sup>™</sup> Mio<sup>™</sup> Advance infusion set is used with all major insulin pump brands with luer-lock or MiniMed<sup>™</sup> connections including Medtronic, Roche and Animas insulin infusion pumps. Only Medtronic MiniMed<sup>™</sup> Mio<sup>™</sup> Advance infusion sets are affected by this FSN

#### BACKGROUND

Unomedical a/s has updated the user guide to recommend that 6mm and 9mm soft cannulae be filled with 0.6U (0.006 ml) of insulin. Reducing the soft cannula insulin fill volume to 0.6U (0.006 ml) will reduce the risk of potential hypoglycaemic events, particularly among paediatric patients.

Users are advised to fill the MiniMed™ Mio™ Advance infusion set soft cannula with insulin as follows:

6mm: 0.6U (0.006 ml)9mm: 0.6U (0.006 ml)
